

# Food Science Summer Enrichment Program

## What is the Food Science Summer Enrichment Program, FSSEP?

FSSEP is an intensive week-long program that is designed to help students develop a better understanding of science through experiential activities in Food Science that are linked to the Florida Standards. Food Science STEM experiential activities investigate the nature of foods, the basis of deterioration, the principles of food production and processing, and the enhancement of foods for the consumer.

The FSSEP will be from June  $13^{th}$  to  $17^{th}$ , 2022 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

# **Learning Objectives**

- Students will learn about food science career opportunities, meet with food science representatives from industry, government and academia and develop research presentation skills
- Become familiar with simple lab equipment
- Recognize that the strength or usefulness of a scientific claim is evaluated through scientific argumentation, which depends on critical and logical thinking, and the active consideration of alternative scientific explanations to explain the data presented
- Describe how scientific inferences are drawn from scientific observations and provide examples from the content being studies

#### **Eligibility**

Students who have completed 6<sup>th</sup> through the 8<sup>th</sup> grades with an interest in the sciences and/ who would like to improve their laboratory skills and learn about food science and the food industry.

#### Cost

There will be a \$125 entry fee for each student.

#### Meals:

Meals will be provided at no cost to the participant. If you choose not to have your child eat at the facility it will be the responsibility of the student to bring his/her own lunch.
